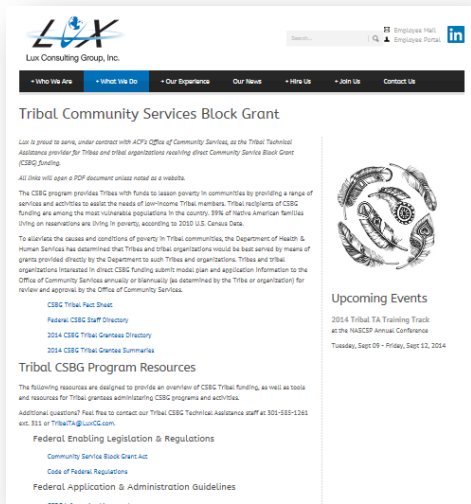




Lux Launches Webpage for Tribal Technical Assistance

Lux has launched a new online resource and technical assistance site for Native American and Alaskan Native anti-poverty efforts funded through the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG).

Indian Tribes and tribal organizations receiving funds under the CSBG program provide services and activities addressing employment, education, housing, and well-being for low-income Tribal members.

The new Tribal Technical Assistance online resource site includes legislative and regulatory overviews, program summaries, fact sheets and directories, as well as a variety of program resource and training materials.
